Royal Rosarian Foundation News Submitted by Sir Knight Gordon Walker



Rosarians love a parade. We love to march, hand out "sticky roses", encourage parade watchers and share our smiles and love of Portland with the crowds. Over the next several months you will have an opportunity to PARTICIPATE in many of these events locally and throughout the Pacific Northwest. Every festival likes to have the other festivals come and be part of their celebration. When 25-30 Rosarians march together, we make an impressive statement; especially with the Royal Rosarian Traveling Float "100 Years of Rosarian Spirit" following us with the large straw Rosarian hat tipping to the audience.

This year we have three out-of-town festivals that I want to encourage as many of you as possible to participate in marching or supporting your fellow Rosarian family. As a group we will officially participate in the Washington State Apple Blossom Festival in Wenatchee

on May 4th-6th. We will march in the parade on Saturday, May 5th at 11:00 AM. Later in May, we will travel to the New Westminster Hyack Festival on May 25th-27th. Their parade will be held on Saturday, May 26th at 11:00 AM. The last festival we will march in as an official group is the Washington State Autumn Leaf Festival in Leavenworth on September 28-30th. The Leavenworth parade is Saturday, Sept. 9th at 11:00 AM.
