The circumstances are varied ranging from multiple orchestra members from a single family, to teens trying to support themselves, to families that are dealing with the effects of the troubled economy."

The Orchestra is currently undertaking an outreach program to grow music programs within the schools of the greater Portland Metropolitan Area not currently having such programs. Our past support has helped tremendously and they look forward to future efforts that can help them expand their reach.

On January 11th, Members of the Royal Rosarians welcomed a group from the China Welfare Institute Children's Palace Little Champion Art Troupe. The group included 44 students and 10 adults. The China Welfare Institute Children's Palace was founded in 1955

by Mme. Soon Ching Ling, the wife of Dr. Sun Yat-sen. Originally for musically talented children, the group, often called the Little Ambassadors from Shanghai, has grown to an enrollment of more than 800 members between aged 5 to 16 years old.

The troupe is active in competition and has performed in more than 20 countries. In 2008 the troupe received the Coming up Taller Award from Laura Bush. The dance troupe performed at Catlin Gabel School on Thursday, January 12th.
