Joe has been honored to receive the Spirit of Portland Award. The Portland Immigrant Statue Project, dedicated to the City of Portland on Parkrose's 100th anniversary, was one of his most gratifying projects. Close to the airport, the statue was



conceived to be "An everlasting symbol of Portland gratitude to our past, present and future immigrant citizens, of all countries, who have made our city great."
