

England, Scotland and Wales, April 14-25, 2015

Dame Marilyn Schultz formally announced her upcoming Prime Minister's Trip at the Membership Meeting on January 30. It is set for April 14-25, 2015 and will take Rosarians and friends to England, Scotland and Wales. The cost will be \$3999 per person including round trip airfare, taxes, hotel transfers, two theater

performances and the usual sightseeing tours. Trip insurance, tips, two extra nights in London and admission to the London eye, Windsor Castle and a famous garden have been added to the standard package.

There will be a four night stay in London, one night in a castle in Wales, two nights in Edinburgh, one night in York and two nights in Stratford-upon-Avon. All accommodations are four-star quality. Ten breakfasts and seven dinners are included.

Marilyn indicates that the most strenuous part of this trip will be getting on and off the bus. There is no excuse to not consider this trip of a lifetime.
