President's Remarks

H2O – the chemical formula for water which is transparent, tasteless, odorless and nearly colourless. We all know that. We also know that, from a biological standpoint, water has many distinct properties that are critical for the proliferation of life. It carries out this role by allowing organic compounds to react in ways that ultimately allow replication. All known forms of life depend on water. No wonder then that civilization has historically flourished around rivers and major waterways; Mesopotamia, the so-called cradle of civilization, was situated between the major rivers Tigris and Euphrates; the ancient society of the Egyptians depended entirely upon the Nile. Rome was also founded on the banks of the Italian river Tiber. Large metropolis like Rotterdam, London, Montreal, Paris, New York City, Buenos Aires, Shanghai, Tokyo, Chicago, and Hong Kong owe their success in part to their easy accessibility via water and the resultant expansion of trade. Islands with safe water ports, like Singapore, have flourished for the same reason. In places such as North Africa and the Middle East, where water is scarcer, access to clean drinking water was and is a major factor in human development.

The five main uses of water are for:

- * Domestic purposes (cooking, drinking, bathing, washing)
- * Agricultural purposes (farming, gardening, fisheries)
- * Industrial purposes (manufacturing)
- * Recreation (swimming, rafting, boating)
- * Hydropower generation
