## Today: **Birgit Wartenberg** **Indigenous Peoples Partnership Committee**

### President's Remarks

Since I joined Rotary a few years ago, I have heard more than once a member say: "We are doing so much locally and even internationally, but how about our own people in the North? Don't they deserve our help and support as much as some community in Central America or Africa?" Apparently unknown to some members, Rotary is very much involved in helping our natives! HIP – Honouring Indigenous People was created by Rotarians in Southern Ontario in partnership and consultation with a number of indigenous people. It now involves five districts which cover a large portion of Ontario. The mission statement states two clearly defined targets:

- \* The education of indigenous people in all its forms and
- \* To promote understanding and awareness of the culture, history and issues of indigenous people to Rotarians and others

The board of HIP will have a minimum of 10 and a maximum of 15 people of which ideally 50% will be indigenous and 50% Rotarians, each having one vote. The selection of Rotarians is drawn from all five participating districts. One current board member, Suzanne Katsi'tsiarishion Brant, is a Mohawk from the Tyendinaga Mohawk Territory.

Not surprisingly, the core values guiding this partnership are not only based on our own 4-Way Test but also the Seven Sacred Anishinaabek Grandfather Teachings: Truth, Humility, Honesty, Respect, Courage, Love and Wisdom.
