Last Week: Ron Stakes Prince Edward Curling Club Project

The Curling Club began in 1913 and ice was rented in the Picton Arena during the 50s and 60s. The Club was incorporated in 1961. The current site was built in 1963.

The Club Board includes 9 volunteers and all staff are also volunteers, putting in about 2200 hours per year.

Membership includes 146 full season and 24 in the learn to curl program. There are also 240 members in the school program.

The building is used for a number of community groups during the off season including and an antique show, the Picton Fair and Fibre Fest.

The floor under the ice surface is in need of replacement. On April 9th, a new floor will be laid over the old concrete. The plan also includes new LED lighting and a new Kitchen facility. The renovations will help promote fitness and social activities across the County. The LED lighting and ice making machine will drastically reduce energy costs.
