- \* International Christian University, Tokyo, Japan
- \* University of Bradford, Bradford, England
- \* University of Queensland, Brisbane, Australia
- \* Uppsala University, Uppsala, Sweden
- \* Chulalongkorn University, Bangkok, Thailand

Through academic training, practice, and global networking opportunities, the Rotary Peace Centers program develops leaders who become catalysts for peace and conflict prevention and resolution. Many of them are serving as leaders at international organizations or have started their own foundations.

As we all know: an ounce of prevention is worth a pound of cure!
