Last Week: Joyce Fowler St. John Ambulance Therapy Dog Program

Joyce Fowler spent 35 years in the military.

The program started in June, 1992 as a pilot program in Peterborough, Ontario and today more than 3,400 therapy dog teams reach thousands annually.

The program is growing, boasting 3,354 therapy dog program volunteers and dog teams in 2015 which assisted more than 120,000 clients throughout the year. Therapy dog teams gave more than 230,000 hours of their time visiting hospitals, providing relief and distraction for patients awaiting cancer treatments. Also, retirement residences, care facilities, schools and universities.

They do bi-weekly visits to the local Chapters book store in the children's section. They will also visit the witness assistance group at the local Belleville courthouse.

Therapy dogs are owned by their handlers and are not formally trained or certified.

Service dogs are more formally trained for one person to aid with some form of disability and are a large financial investment.

Therapy dogs love to be petted but treats are not encouraged. They will start their work at one year and are evaluated for suitability at several levels depending on where they serve. Evaluation will include temperament and command observance.
