Last Week: Fergus Millar-Alexandra Bake Picton Library Expansion

If you're one of the 3,400 people who visit Picton Library every month, you know that our 111-year-old Carnegie building is overdue for expansion.

A consultation process featured Town Hall meetings, On-Line surveys and Focus Groups to gather public ideas and feedback.

You can expect:

- Expanded collection
- Performance arts space with non-profit rental options
- A new lecture theatre with assistive technologies
- An enlarged children's area and a dedicated Makerspace
- Room for STEM learning and lifelong enrichment
- Flexible quiet workspaces and meeting room rentals
- Accessible public washrooms
- Comfortable chairs, good lighting, quiet spaces where we can all feel at home
- A new walkway from Mary Street to Main Street

- 3D Printers in Picton and Wellington booked 1 year inadvance

The addition will add about 6,000 ft² to the rear and side so as not to adversely alter the street scrape. A walkway to Mary St. will facilitate people movement.

The free WiFi will be expanded and will include take-home hot-spots for those without home access.

Project expected to cost \$1,280,000 Funding from PEC and Parrot Foundation, plus Ont. Gov't. Need to raise about \$720,000 from fundraising in the community.
