The hosting club, Stirling, included our group in their monthly social gathering for a very informal dinner. So like a big family we all sat down in their meeting room, munched on take-away pizza and had a glass of wine (or water in my case – how sad!).

While enjoying the company of Rotarians from various places I learned a couple of interesting facts about the Stirling club. While the current club was chartered in April 1996 under the guidance of Wilf Wilkinson, it actually existed before. In 1983, after being chartered in 1949, the then-secretary Allan Wells wrote the District Governor Eric Nieminen informing him that as "Moved by Jack Miller, seconded by Tom McClung, Stirling Rotary Club disband and surrender our charter as of December 31, 1983. Motion carried."

In the Rotary year 2001/2002 they took on the biggest challenge of all. They began the project to move and restore the Stirling Grand Trunk/CN Railway Station and build a community hall in the lower level which is now called The Rotary Hall and serves as their meeting place. While that part was done a while ago to the tune of more than \$ 250'000, the club is now working on establishing a park right beside the

Station. Once finished, it will be a beautiful place for Stirling – well worth a visit!
