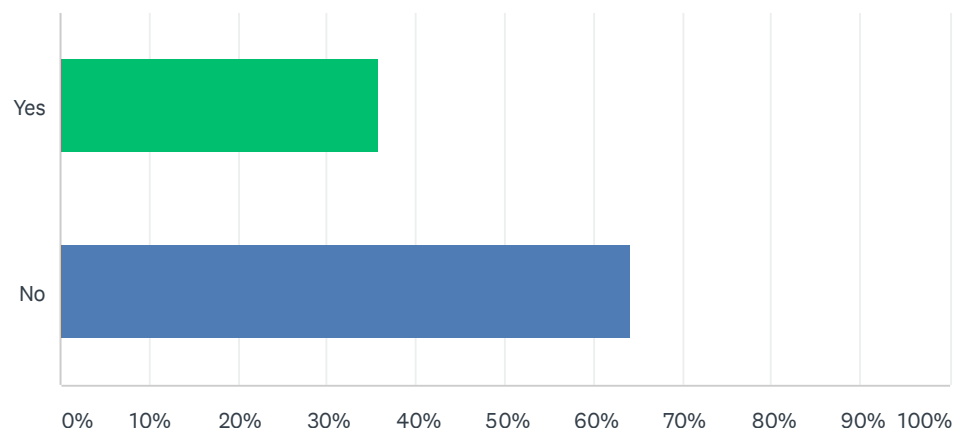


## Q1 Currently, two meetings are held each month. Would you suggest changes to the number of meetings per month

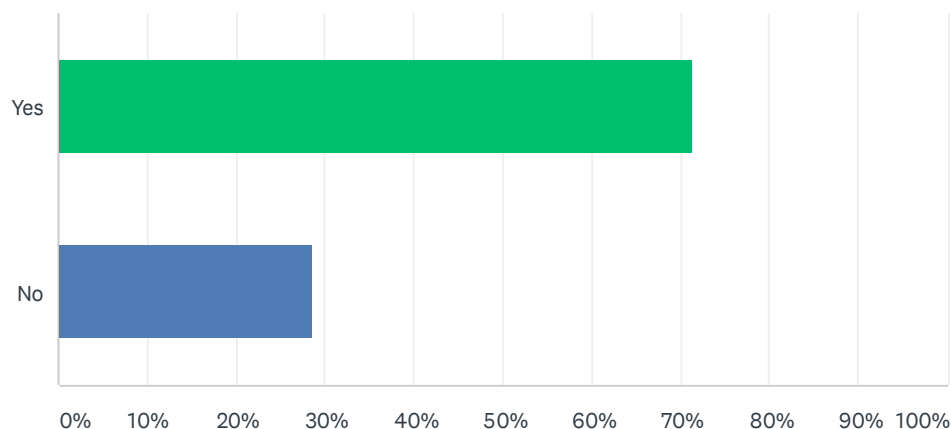

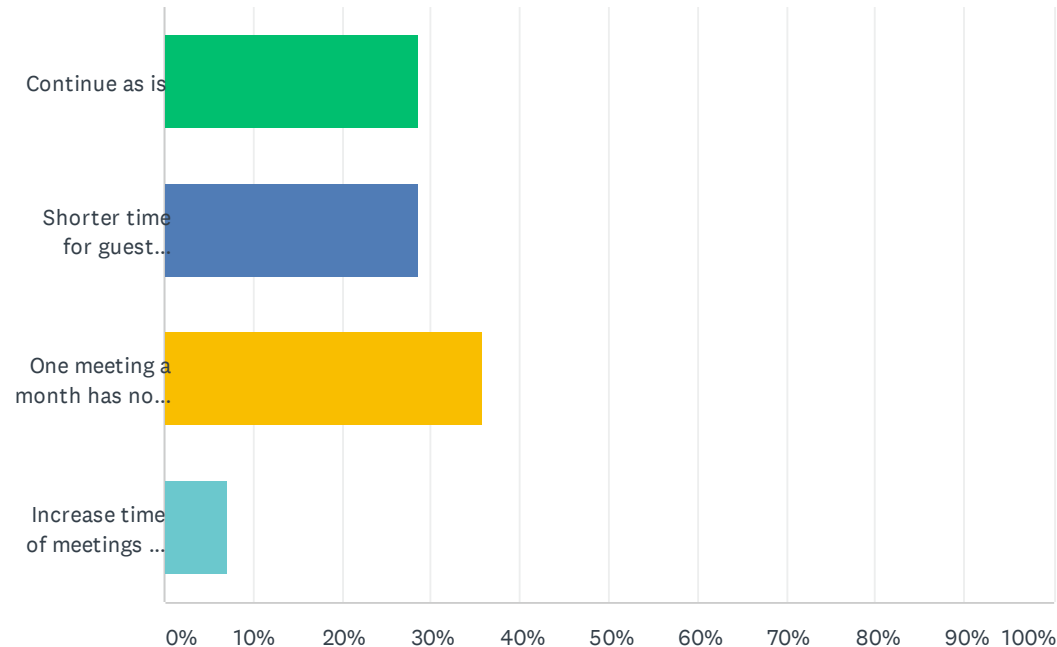

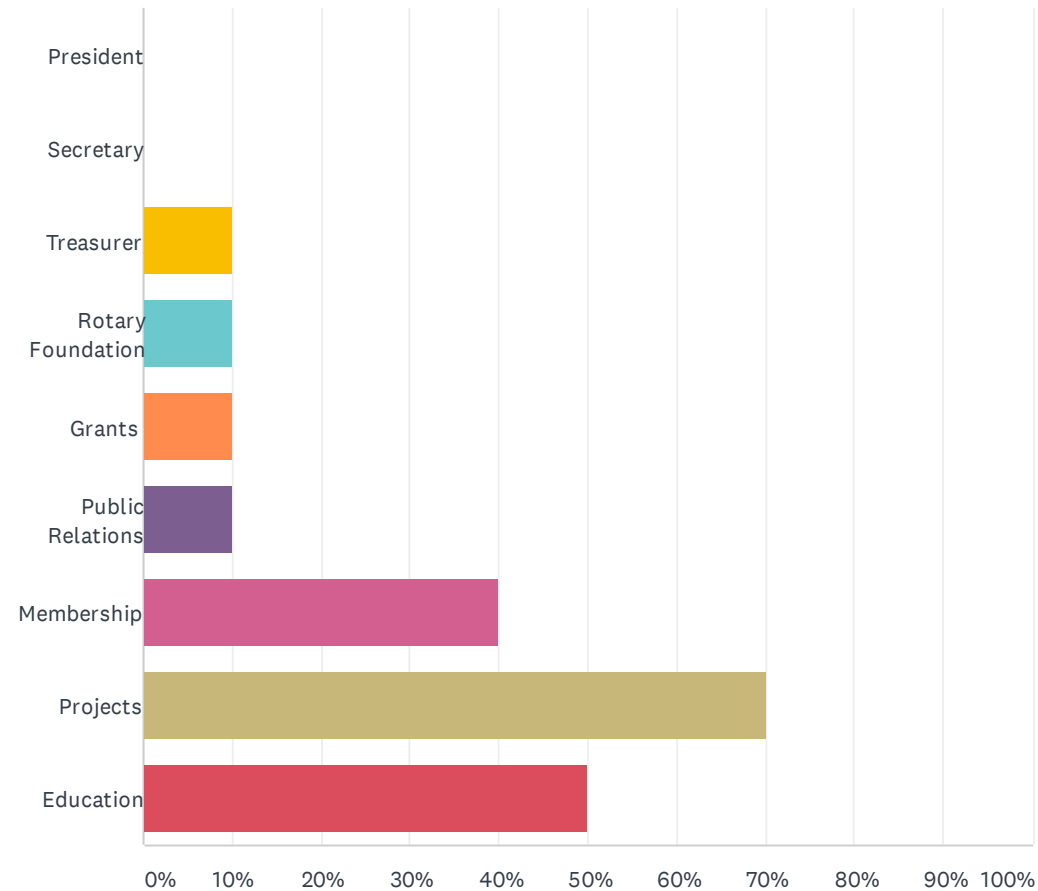
