Community Group, Club and Charity FAQ's

Q: Why should we volunteer as a community group/club?

It is fun way to get amongst the action whilst raising money for your community group.

\$50 will be given back to the club, community group or charity per member who volunteers for each day that they volunteer.

Q: Is there a minimum number of members required to be eligible for the fundraising component?

Yes- A minimum of **5 group members** must register.

Q: Can we bulk register our group or send through the names for you to register?

No. Unfortunately, all members will need to register individually as this allows us to capture any dietary requirements, t-shirt details, emergency contact details etc.

Where prompted, members will be asked to list their club/group name, in addition to their Team Leader's details. Please refer to page 1, illustrating the questions you and you members will be required to complete.

Q: If I am the Team Leader do I just register myself and then put myself in as Team Leader where prompted?

Yes- this will keep registrations amongst your group consistent.

Q: Does our group all have to volunteer on the same day?

No. Members of your group can select to volunteer across the week of the event (21/1/2019-28/1/2019).

Sport Projects encourage all Team Leaders to be aware of the day/s their members are volunteering.

Q: Are there any age restrictions?

You must be **at least 15** years of age on 24 January 2019 to volunteer.

Q: How do they get paid or does the money go to the team leader?

Money will be transferred to the nominated bank account supplied by the Team Leader.

Q: Is the money paid by bank transfer (if so do you need bank account details) or by cheque?

Money will be paid by bank transfers at completion of the event. Please note, payment will be made after the event once all invoices have been approved and processed.
