Ron De Carli, Executive Director San Luis Obispo Council of Governments (SLOCOG)

Ron De Carli is a frequent speaker at our Rotary Club, reflecting the keen interest in transportation projects and issues within our county. Ron is currently focused on upcoming ballot initiative that would impose an

additional ½ cent sales tax within SLO County for 9 years. The measure is intended to help qualify SLO as a "Self Help" county. This designation would better enable the county to access state matching funds for local transportation projects. Currently, there are 20 counties statewide with this designation and 8 counties (including SLO) with ballot measures. Ron noted that if the tax increase is approved it would generate \$25 M per year for state matching transportation grants essential to move



many local transportation projects forward. It is estimated that over 50% of the sales tax would be paid by non-residents and the measure has provisions to ensure local control of these funds. The measure requires a 2/3 approval by voters to pass. The measure also calls for the delivery of a Transportation Investment Plan to inform stakeholders of the various projects to be funded.
