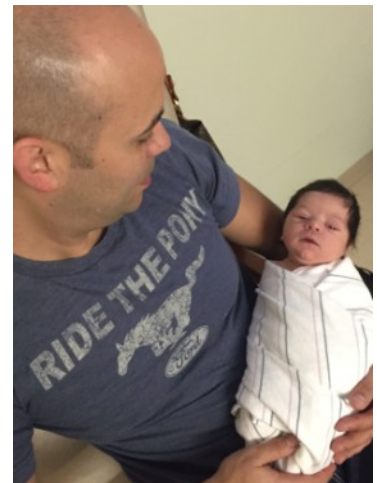
Dear Rotary Family,

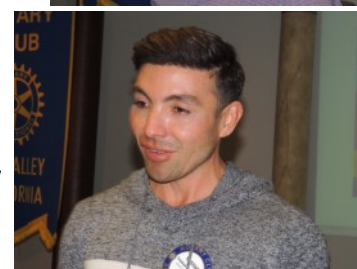
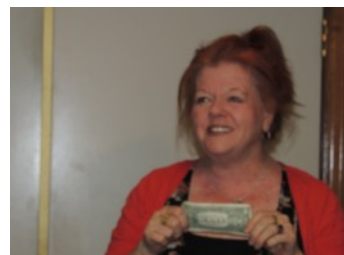
Paige was born on 2/16/2016 at 4:09pm and weighed 7lbs 3oz and is 20 and 3/4 inches long.

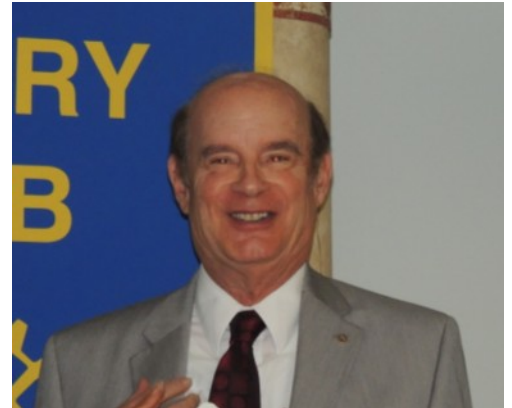
