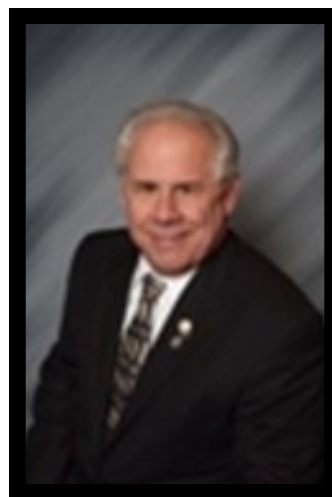
Please wear your red jacket to the funeral and reception if you have one.

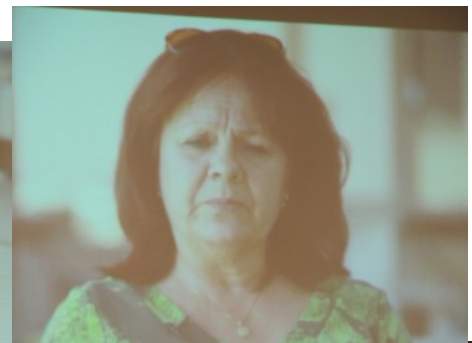
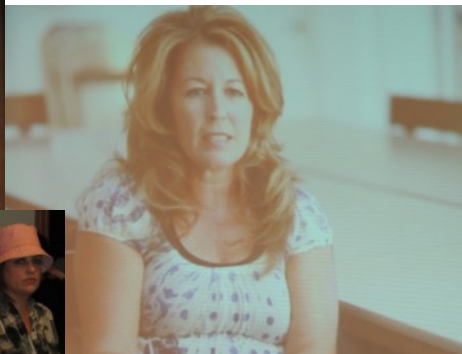
The Samaritan Center

With the upcoming storms and cold weather, Betty appreciated the club's donation of much needed survival kits. Also needed are jackets, white socks and underwear for the winter season.

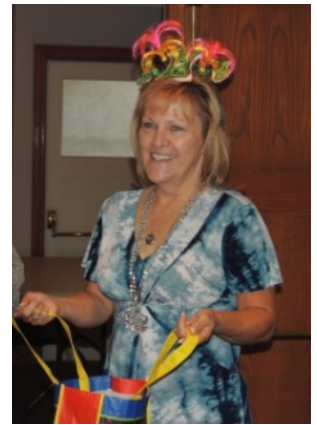

Happy Bucks!

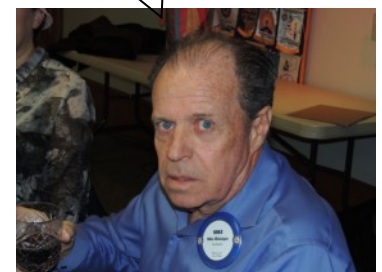
