



Dear members we hope you are all keeping well & slowly easing back into some normality in life. Recent events in Victoria make us all aware how tenuous our hold is on Covid free status.

Last Monday the committee met at the bowling club rooms along with Shirley Branson, representing the bowling club. She explained the requirements to abide with the Covid safe rules. Not abiding by these rules can incur a \$5000 fine to them & individual fines of \$1000. Since then some rules have changed, which will mean we can meet in the smaller room now, as it can now accommodate 40 people. However distancing rules will require people to sit on alternate seats.

We have decided at this stage to start meeting again on <u>August the 17th</u>, providing nothing changes in the mean time. We urge all members to abide by the following restrictions to make us compliant with regulations.

- 1. Members will enter by one door & exit by another
- 2. They will use hand sanitizer on entering
- 3. They will be required to enter name & phone number on sheet supplied
- 4. Alternate seats must be used in meeting room
- 5. For afternoon tea only 6 people may sit at a table & only tables indicated may be used
- 6. Only 3 people may be in the kitchen
- 7. Social distancing must be maintained when lining up for tea & coffee.
- 8. Members will take & return own badges & names will be written in the book by person on the door (no individual signing on)

- *For added hygiene & convenience we would ask people to bring their own cup. Some disposable cups will be provided.
- *Individual sugar & stirring sticks will be provided.
- *One person will add the milk
- *Individual biscuit packs will be provided (like those in hotel rooms)
