Head office is in Parramatta. He requested that a percentage of funds raised by each club be given to RF. Paul Harris Society membership costs \$1,000 per year. Becoming a Centurion costs \$100 per year. District Grants run for 12 months. Rotarians must be involved hands-on in any project.
