It was very interesting, and the new kitchen, which was part funded by Rotary, is very smart and modern.• Josie also attended Balaklava Probus 18th birthday luncheon. Music provided by talented Balaklava High music students. Josie intends to return in order to promote next year's art show.• Bert Palmer and his daughter are moving to Gawler, and tonight was Bert's last meeting with us. He thanked the club for their fellowship in the past. Best of luck, Bert, for the move.• Josie would like to organise a table of ten for the High Tea and Jazz Soiree to raise funds for the Town Hall new tables on Sun 11th November.• The treasurer has paid Gallery 24/7 their annual fee in preparation for the next Art Show.• Glen W advised that planning for RYDA is well underway. Schools are already booked for 5/6 June 2019.• David Dunstan announced the impending closure of his electrical business, after 70 years of operation. He is looking forward to his retirement, though sad to leave his staff, customers and suppliers.• Bill Singleton introduced Dr Helen MacDonald, CEO of CGVC since last Feb. She was the CEO of Naracoorte/Lucindale Council for 6 years. Prior to that, she worked in the mining industry, primarily dealing with native title and indigenous relations. She spent 8 years in Denver, Colorado after that. She became the general manager of a mining project in Ghana – not easy for a female in that country. Her role with our Council is to provide support for collective members. The current strategic plan needs to be upgraded. A recent audit of Council found a clean bill of health. The current IT system desperately needs upgrading, as it at risk of collapse. Local councils are one of the most closely monitored sectors. This may get worse if the current State Govt has its way. Storm water management needs attention. This will be a big future challenge. The Northern Areas, Goyder and CGVC are working strongly together to share employees and cut costs. Council recently received a million dollar windfall due to the drought. The funds are designed to put money into the local economy. The money needs to be spent by June 30th 2019. Proposed Art Gallery – Council has a number of very audacious plans for this, and also for the sporting complex as well. The cost of the Gallery comes in at approx. 14 million dollars. Running costs are not clear currently. A business case is being prepared. Helen's door is always open for questions or comment. Thanks for an interesting address, Helen.
