Guest Speaker: Cliff Callanan— PNG APEC Experiences

- Paramedic
- Attended the APEC conference Papua New Guinea Nov 2018 medical contingent
- St John in PNG very basic therefore wanted 100 people with better training for a few days
- Basic stats about PNG: 600 islands, pop 8million, 1000 distinct groups, 820 dialects, most bilingual, average income \$3789, \$3.50 per hour, education-hit and miss, major health issues – inadequate resources and facilities,
- Cultural practices
 - Cannibalism less frequent, dowry payments,
 - Dances- each tribe have distinct regalia
 - Suspected witches still burnt at stake
- Need to be cautious regarding safety government hire private security, armed taxi drivers, domestic violence
- APEC to encourage economic growth in region
- 21 members from Asia and pacific region
- Leaders meet annually for 3 days
- First time held in such a poor country
- Preparation
 - Building infrastructure, venues, hotels, airport upgrade
 - security prep
 - Major medical prep
 - Large foreign money input
 - Employment, transport, accommodation, import and purchase of equipment
- Support medical facilities and provide medical coverage during Conference
- St John voluntary and run out of a shed and had new, much better centre set up with better equipment etc
- Many women drivers
- Shifts ad hoc, some countries had own medical team
- Political games and issues
- Lack of food, co-ordination, organisation, medication supplies, limits of fund transfers, poor management of security
- Protests and controversy
- New friendships formed
