Guest Speaker: Ian Curtis—Australian Poultry Industry

- Industry has grown dramatically over last 3 decades
- Chicken consumption now exceeds beef, lamb and pork
- Employs over 40000 people directly and 120000 indirectly
- Chicken meat industry subscribes to government endorsed model code of practice
- 6 companies provide the chicken stock
- 1 million chicks hatched each week
- Breeder farms provide 5 star accommodation
- All fertilised eggs are gathered 4 times a day and sent to the hatcheries
- Fertile eggs incubated for 21 days
- Controlled environment mimics mother hen
- Australia is second in the world to Brazil in total chicken consumption per head of 48kgs
- Market requirements dictate size of the bird
- Computer controlled environment ensures ideal condition for chickens
- Critical aspects include height of water receptacle and feed outlets
- Ventilation—air is introduced under the eaves to reduce relative humidity and extracted at the end of the shed
- 3-5% loss of chicks during life cycle
- 63 years of genetic history ensure selection of best traits
- Chicken price per kg cheaper than other protein sources
- Equal opportunity employer
- 53 different employment opportunities
- Chicken feet exported to Korea
- Feathers– amino acids extracted for pet food supplement
