Providing a home-in-a-box in emergencies - including Harvey

Four years ago, Mat-Su psychologist, Nancy Dodge, became aware of another way of helping people -- ShelterBox -- and she volunteered to be Alaska's ambassador. Dodge quickly learned of the charity's partnership with Rotary. (She joined the district e-club in 2014 and is president-elect.)

Dr. Dodge moved to Alaska 37 years ago, after working with inmates in New Jersey. During her Alaska career, from which she retired a



year ago, she worked in schools, mental health facilities, and juvenile centers as an administrator, trainer, and psychologist.

ShelterBox was founded in England in 2000 and was the first official project partner of Rotary International. ShelterBox monitors weather tracking systems to anticipate areas of emergency displacement. ShelterBox coordinates with Rotary and international relief organizations to deliver the boxes within 2-3 days. Each box contains a heavy-duty tent, water purification, lantern, tools, blankets, and cooking supplies. Each box costs about \$1,000 and is numbered



so that donors can track it.

ShelterBoxUSA is working with FEMA to deliver tents, solar lights, groundsheets, and school kits to those displaced by this week's hurricane Harvey. Go to: Shelterboxusa.org/ harvey to help.

Board gives nod to Ugandan water, hygiene project

The JGR board last Friday approved a request for \$500 toward a Ugandan water and hygiene project. The effort is in conjunction with an Evanston, IL, Rotary, of which JGR's former president, John Robertson, is a member. Objectives of the project are to: - Provide 10 clean water wells in three rainshadow sub-counties of Uganda

- Prevent malaria by providing mosquito netting to pregnant moms and school kids

- Teach sanitation standards in ten schools
