Driven by the core belief that every student deserves a quality arts education, Ensuring the Arts for Any Given Child (AGC) Juneau is a collaboration of local arts and cultural organizations, business, government, community members, and educators, backed by John F. Kennedy Center for the Performing Arts in Washington, D.C. The goals of AGC are



to sustain and expand school district programs for learning through the arts, to support teachers and teaching artists, and to engage the community in advocating for the value of arts and cultural learning.

Three current goals of AGC in Juneau include:

- Bus excursions to support "exceptional annual experiences" for each student
- Collaborate to test a measuring system to ensure equitable access to art
- Community outreach to promote AGC

Former pre-school teacher and classroom volunteer Jen LaRoe has been the AGC liaison to the Juneau Arts & Humanities Council for 18 months.
