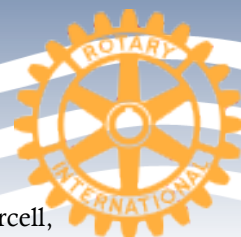

The Alaska Design Forum is a non-profit organization of architects, artists, and designers formed to broaden the range of discussion of design and the built environment. According to its website, "the goal of ADF is to motivate people to discuss, think, and ultimately act to create a built environment that inspires the soul and protects the body."

The 24-year-old ADF, with chapters in Anchorage, Fairbanks, and Juneau, presents live programs that expose the community to

leading edge design and art ideas.

All ADF programs are posted at alaskadesignforum.org.

ADF, which is funded in part by the National Endowment for the Arts, the Alaska State Council on the Arts, and the Anchorage Museum, hosts lectures, publishes a journal, sponsors design competitions, commissions original art and artist-in-residence programs, and organizes tours in other countries (such as Iceland and Chile) to connect travelers with artists and architects.

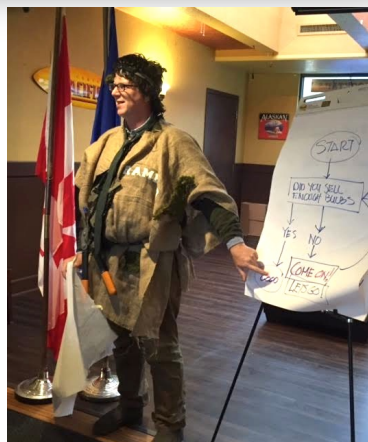
