Commission in its fifth decade of helping Alaskans finance their educational pursuits

Since 1974, the Alaska Commission on Post-Secondary Education has supported generations of Alaskans as they have pursued higher learning. Last year alone, more than 2,000 students received support from the ACPE, totally \$21 million from amongst three programs it administers (loans, grants, and Performance Scholarships). The commission is funded through the Alaska Student

Loan Corporation which has authority to sell tax-exempt bonds. The corporation a couple months ago also launched a loan re-financing program, which already has made awards of nearly \$2 million.

The new executive director of the commission (and CEO of the corporation) is Stephanie Butler, above, who has been with the organization nearly 20 years. Butler, who had served as director of program operations since 2001, holds a certified internal auditor credential, as well as a BS in business administration and management and a BA in English.
