Locals return to Juneau to bring investment home

Legacy Partners plan Auke Bay flex space

Two Juneau-born-and-bred men have returned to their roots to invest locally with a focus on job creation. Paul Simpson, top, and Garrett Schoenberger, middle, have formed Alaska Legacy Partners. Their first project is The Jetty, "flex" retail and office space for lease in the former Horton's Hardware/UAS bookstore across from Statter Harbor.

According to the pair, "ALP was created with the vision of filling a unique niche in the Alaska real estate world. With an intimate knowledge of Alaska's real estate landscape, ALP's main focus is to identify assets with unrecognized value that present above-average returns." Schoenberger, who grew up in Auke Bay, worked as a commercial real estate broker in Phoenix and most recently as director of acquisitions for Curtis Capital in Bellevue. 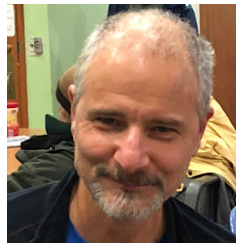

30 years making thousands of meals



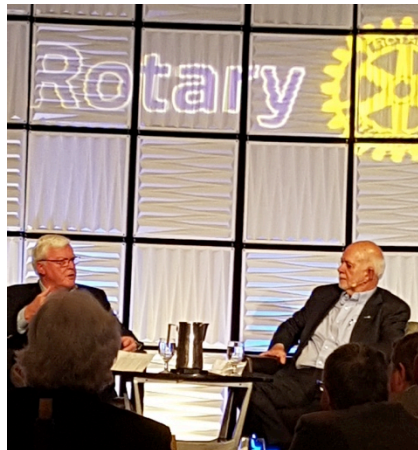

Rotary International President-Elect, Barry Rassin (far right) and Vice President-Elect John Mathews (immediate right) were featured speakers. Said Kim, "Wow! How to describe PETS? We learned about the Foundation, District and Global Grants and, from Barry Rassin, how important it is for us to take care of our world. He lives in Bermuda and if sea levels continue to rise as predicted, Bermuda will be under water in 50 years. We heard first-hand about growing up with polio and how we are so very close (to eradication) – only one case so far this year. We have a revolving door on membership, bringing in new members at the pace that they leave. We networked on what works and how we can continue to be relevant."
