Shortly after Racheal MacLeod and her husband, Dan, moved to Juneau in 1988, she spearheaded a Christmas food box project with other members of the Juneau Yacht Club. Known as the "bird whisperer" due to her love of feathered and furry animals, Racheal died in 2014, at 65. Since then, the three Rotarys of Juneau, Rotaract, and Interact have coordinated the filling of the food boxes, which are distributed by the Salvation Army.
