Shortly after Racheal MacLeod and her husband, Dan, moved to Juneau in 1988, she spearheaded a Christmas food box project with other members of the Juneau Yacht Club. Since then, the three Rotaries of Juneau, Rotaract, and Interact have coordinated the filling of the food boxes, which are distributed by the Salvation Army.
