### **Reflection of place an essential component of arts complex**

Major steps toward the proposed Willoughby Arts Complex have been achieved in 2016, according to pre-construction project manager, Katharine Heumann of the Juneau Arts & Humanities Council (JAHC). About a halfmillion was secured to sponsor an architectural competition and to complete the conceptual design phase (by NorthWind). That process included three public forums, during which there was strong sentiment to remove the old Armory, currently housing the JAHC. The proposed community center, including a 300seat theater and a 400-person main hall, is estimated to cost \$25million. It's hoped that fundraising will allow groundbreaking in 2018 and opening in 2020.
