In-House Workshop Affinity Diagram

The affinity diagram is a business tool used to organize ideas and data. It is one of the Seven Management and Planning Tools. People have been grouping data into groups based on natural relationships




for thousands of years; however, the term affinity diagram was devised by Jiro Kawakita in the 1960s and is sometimes referred to as the KJ Method. The objective of the process is to obtain multiple inputs from several persons on a problem or issue in a structured format. The process prevents the domination of discussion by a single person, encourages the more passive persons to participate, results in a set of prioritized solutions or recommendations and is a structured way to reach consensus. Criticism or ridicule of another person's idea is prohibited. Karen Ellis will lead today's session.
