Regarding Ron Wilson

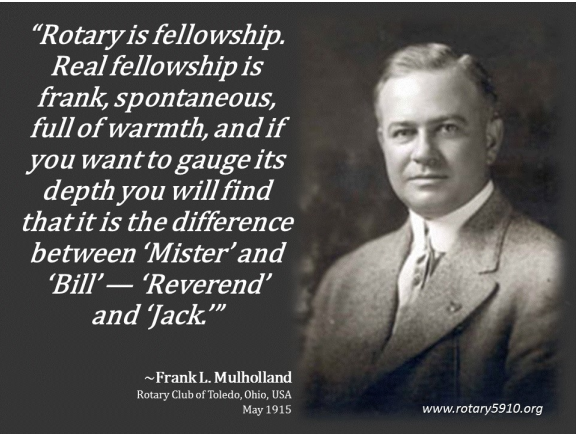


The following message was received from Ron and Karen Wilson on May 2nd and missed publication in an earlier edition:
