We had winners in three categories. Ugliest - Michele McManus, Most creative - MaryJo Fenyn and Most Christmasy - Fred and Trudy Hicks.



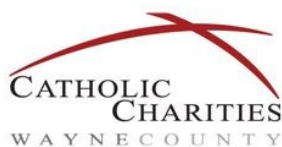
HAPPY MOMENTS
