## Speaker - Karen Quartaro

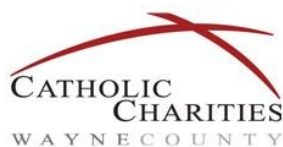

Karen was inspired to help others to avoid this type of situation. Volunteers are needed to help in the national program "We Honor Veterans". Karen has been a part of the pinning ceremonies for 67 veterans. The veterans receive a flag, a blanket, a pen and a certificate. We watched a video of Col. Michael J Healy, considered the champion of the "We Honor Veterans" program. He died on Memorial Day this year. Remember that hospice can be wherever you are living.
