Scholarship highlights...

- Graduate studies abroad
- Plan to pursue career in field of study
- 1 to 2 year scholarship
- Minimum of \$30,000 per year
- Must be proficient in language of country
- Based on...
 - Academic merit
 - Studying a Rotary Area of Focus
 - Residence in or attendance at a college in District 7390

Rotary's Areas of Focus are...

- Peace and Conflict Prevention/Resolution
- Disease Prevention and Treatment
- Water and Sanitation
- Maternal and Child Health
- Basic Education and Literacy
- Economic and Community Development.

The deadline to apply for a Global Grant Scholarship is January 13, 2018. The interviews will be held February 17, 2018 and applicants MUST be available for the interviews on that date.
