SPEAKERS REVIEW by Matt Holliday

Jack Wintermute introduced the first of our two speakers, Chris who is the General Manager of the Wilmington Blue Rocks was our first speaker. Chris briefly addressed the fact that the

Ownership of the Blue Rocks is currently trying to purchase an AA franchise, so they would then be in the same league as the Reading Phillies. If they were to do this they would be moved under the Umbrella of the New York Mets and they would no longer be affiliated with the Kansas City Royals.
