SPEAKER'S REVIEW By Glen Sweet

After being introduced by **Bob Frame**, Dr. Lewis began on a seasonal note stating that his Wall Rx product, as seen on "Shark Tank", was the result of a Christmas tree rolling down the stairs and "harpooning" a wall in his home. When he was unable to fix the hole himself, he called a handyman who performed the traditional spackle fix for a mere \$350. That was when he decided he could invent a product to simply repair interior drywall holes. "I can do this; I am a forensic pathologist!"

Many, many holes later, with a shop in his garage, he thought he had perfected the product. He met with an attorney and secured some investors.

Dr. Lewis' wife told him he should try the "Shark Tank" audition in Philadelphia. There was a very long line even early in the morning and he was about to give up when he was persuaded to stay. The group was finally whittled down to 25 people. The group was told they would be contacted if they were to proceed in the process.

Dr. Lewis' Wall Rx was potentially selected for the show. He said there was a three month vetting process followed by three months dealing with the producers of the show over the 90 second video presentation. When it was all said and done, he was given a ticket to the show in Culver City, CA, with the indication that he might possibly get on the show (which he never watched).

In Culver City, Dr. Lewis was selected as a possible contestant. In preparation for the show, there was a

long pre-pitch discussion with the show's lawyers advising Dr. Lewis what he could not do during the filming. He said he had to stand for two minutes without moving prior to the filming. Some of the products featured on the show, such as Scrub Daddy, have been on the market for several years prior to the show. It thus becomes a means of marketing the product. Dr. Lewis concluded saying that "Shark Tank" is much more about the show than getting investors for a product.
