SPEAKER REVIEW by Chris Feryo

Angel Flight East (AFE) is a nonprofit organization dedicated to serving the community by facilitating free air transportation to children and adults in need of non-emergency medical treatment far from home and other compelling needs. AFE's footprint is Virginia to Ohio to Maine and for destinations beyond that; we link up with other volunteer pilot organizations.

Angel Flight East's network has over 400 small plane pilots who provide air transportation to people who need to travel long distances for medical care purposes. The network makes over 800 flights per year in 14 states. The service is free to the patients and their caregivers and there is no limit on the number of flights provided.

Angel Flight East alleviates the burden of travel for families so that proper medical treatment can be sought in areas that are otherwise not easily accessible. The pilots pay all of the travel expenses associated with the mission, for example: fuel, airport fees and maintenance. They partner with other groups providing complimentary services to patients such as lodging in order to help the families find their service.
