SPEAKERS' REVIEW by Glen Sweet

Sheriff **Bunny Welsh** gave an introduction to the "Shop with the Sheriff" program of her office. The program benefits Chester County Family Academy (CCFA) students. CCFA is a small charter school for grades K-2. The school principally serves disadvantaged and at-risk children. On December 5, 2015, over 110 CCFA students will travel by Krapf's buses to the Wal-Mart in Kennett Square. The buses will be escorted by Chester County Sheriff's cars and SUVs complete with flashing lights and sirens.

Sheriff Welsh then turned the program over to Chester County Deputy Harry McKinney who instituted the program. He began by saying the Sheriff's Office is seeking donations to fund this wonderful day with a tax deductible donation. Each donation will be matched dollar for dollar by the Wal-Mart Corporation so that each child will receive a \$100 Wal-Mart gift card to purchase holiday gifts for their family and themselves. The children will be accompanied by a uniformed deputy sheriff who will assist them while they shop for their purchases.

Deputy McKinney described how "Shop with the Sheriff" met the Rotary Four Way Test. He also showed a video of the children shopping at the 2014 event.
