Thank you for supporting the Commemorative Prime Minister Wine



This was the first year we had two delicious Oregon wines, complimented with a 2-bottle wine bag. And this is the second year we've been able to release and sell the new PM wine at the PM Ball. The Prime Minister wine is part of each PM experience.

This year's wines: 2021 Brandborg Bench Lands Pinot Noir, Umpqua Valley 2021 Airlie Seven | White Wine Blend, Willamette Valley Choosing the PM wine entails a complex process that spans approximately 15 steps over several months. These steps involve discussing specific

varietals, determining the ideal region and winery to source the wine from, conducting tastings, establishing a timeline for ordering, deciding on the quantity to order, coordinating delivery logistics, arranging storage for over 30 cases of wine, creating a label design and applying labels to each bottle, and finally, determining dates for resale.

If you have any inquiries regarding this process or feedback to enhance future selections, please don't hesitate to reach out to the wine chair.
