The first event of the Portland Rose Festival is the Blessing of the Festival. This tradition memorializes the members and spouses of members of the Portland Rose Festival Foundation, Portland Rose Society, Blueback Council of the Navy League, and the Royal Rosarians who have passed away during the previous year. It is also a Memorial Service hosted by the Royal Rosarians. The second portion of the event asks for a blessing on the Rose Festival and its participants.
