

Role of the RLA Small Learning Groups, 2022-23

- Get acquainted with one another—You have emails and phone #s of the student and faculty on the Faculty/Student list.
- Select the best day and time for your group to meet. Groups typically meet once monthly for one hour.
- Rotate the roles of “meeting scheduler” (schedules and distributes the Zoom link) and “meeting facilitator” (facilitates the group’s Zoom meeting).
- Share Rotary interests with one another with a particular focus on your learning group topic.
- As a group, decide upon the focus for each of the meetings (questions associated with the month’s course and/or issues and challenges associated with your group’s topic).
- Be available to discuss courses and provide learning support one another during the RLA year
- Recommend prominent Rotary topics for the RLA students and faculty to discuss in one hour Zoom session. (One per semester).
- Each small group will have a faculty support person.
