We had the support of other service clubs, both State and Federal members and some businesses, but the landlords, Council bureaucracy, and the elected members would not permit our sign to be put anywhere in Blackwood. Despite the value of this sign project to our Club, Terry finally conceded defeat.

All members present then acknowledged Terry's efforts. The \$17,000 budget allocation to this project has been absorbed into this year's budget. All committees had set an ambitious budget targets this Rotary year, and the absorption of the electronic sign money prevented severe cuts being made to some committee's request for funds.

## 2. Club programming and the Christmas Pageant

To encourage full participation by every member of our Club, our families and our "Friends of Rotary" in the Christmas Pageant being held on Friday 6<sup>th</sup> December, the Board approved transferring our meeting from Tuesday 10 to Friday the 6<sup>th</sup> of December.
