3. Successful raffle and community BBQs

A fun night followed including a table quiz with a prize of a folding basket full of gifts, a secret game of charades focusing on Christmas carols, a raffle for two meat trays, a silent auction of two items which were not able to be included in the community raffle and the sale of hand-made wine bags donated by Hilary Flynn. Money raised from the meat tray raffle and wine bag sales went to add to items under the giving tree and money raised from the silent auction added to the total of the community raffle.

The meeting closed at about 9.15 with all present acknowledging the contribution that Michael McClaren made to the night. Everyone also thanked our House of Zen host, Hung. Bernie then wished all members and friends a Merry and safe Christmas holiday period. He reminded all
