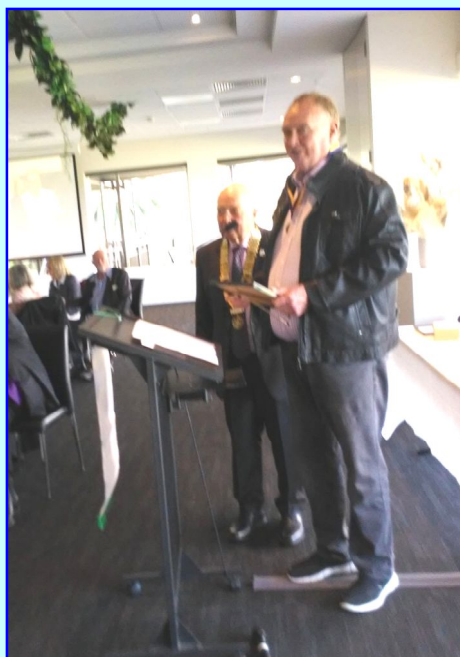

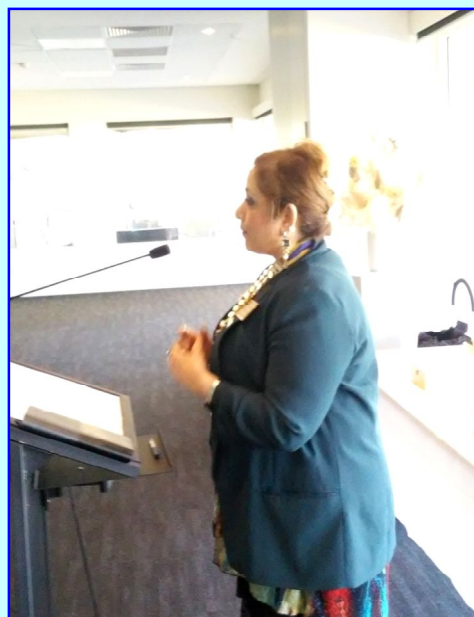
Wayne Leaves after receiving his Paul Harris Fellowship from President Max.
