**On Tuesday 19 November**, we will have as guest speakers, Bill Stupple and Peter Brice from the **South Australian Sea Rescue Squadron**.

The Sea rescue Squadron is located off Barcoo Road West Beach and as the name implies, is an emergency service for all forms of water activities in Gulf St Vincent.

It is a volunteer organisation and is manned 7 days a week to try to keep people safe in our waters. There are other centres at Edithburgh, Wirrina and Copper Coast.

From February to June 2019, the Sea Rescue Squadron has been involved in 71 incidents with 82 people assisted. Fortunately there were no deaths during that time.





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### Past Meetings

At our meeting on Tuesday **1 October**, we had as Guest Speaker **Sue Dugan, Community Development Officer** with the City of Holdfast Bay.

Her role is to find out what is needed in the community and then to find the means to resolve those needs.

Sue works with the Council Volunteer Coordinator to often use volunteers or volunteer groups to help with resolving community needs.

Rotary Clubs are one source of people who can help or run a community project. We have done this in recent years; the Brighton Pump Track being a good example of such a project.

Sue held a similar position with the City of Salisbury before coming to Holdfast Bay.

As well as aiding younger people to integrate within the community, there are 4 community centres which are mostly frequented by the older generations.

We advised Sue that we were willing to look at any activity with the view to help if possible.

In addition to a very interesting guest speaker, it was very pleasing to see an excellent attendance of 22 members at this meeting.

On Tuesday **15 October**, we had **Pam Hewitt** from the **Glenelg Community Club Inc** speak to us on the Glenelg Community Centre located at 4 Colley Terrace Glenelg.

Pam is the President of the club and she spoke to us about the community centre.

The building was erected on council land between May and November 1964 using funds raised by local service clubs in Rotary, Soroptimists, Lions and Kiwanis.

These funds were matched by government at the time.

The centre, now 55 years old is managed by a committee of volunteers and council.

The community centre is open to all but is used mainly by senior citizens for exercise groups, Tai Chi and Yoga and the construction of wooden toys etc in a well equipped workshop. These are sold through their craft shop to raise money to cover operating expenses.

When questioned about how we could assist, Pam advised that signage advising of what they do would be very useful.
