Glenelg Surf Lifesaving Club

What a brilliant project! We liaised with the Glenelg Surf Lifesaving Club before last summer to find out what they would like to help them save lives following three drownings in the water adjacent to the treacherous Glenelg breakwater. Past President Bill and the Lifesaving Club approved the installation of an LED warning sign on top of the club building but this was too expensive and its effectiveness was later thought to be minimal. The Surf Lifesaving Club then expressed a wish for an all terrain patrol vehicle (ATV) to increase their patrol effectiveness, and during 2019, we were able to raise the \$12000 needed; \$10000 from our own fundraising efforts plus \$2000 from a Rotary District Grant.
