Kym had been deferred as speaker earlier due to COVID restrictions and it was pleasing to meet her and to hear some of her thoughts on the operation of Minda Inc and the plans for its future.

Kym has a strong background in health and disability management and has spent much of her career in Oueensland.

Minda is a large scale operation by any standard and has been a major contributor to the welfare of its clients for 122 years.

Minda has a number of operational and profit making arms including **laundry services and environmental care services** but of course is highly dependent on government funding through the National Disability Insurance Scheme, (NDIS). Individuals elect to have Minda manage their allocated funds to provide for their needs within that budget.

This year, the COVID-19 lockdown was managed effectively, and clients without family connections, (many) had an appointed advocate to take care of changing needs.

We also welcomed guests **Phil and Kathy Holgate** to the meeting and hope to see them again.

Possible 2021 Club Project

PP Bill brought a possible club project to the attention of members at the last meeting of 2020. It's called "KICKSTART FOR KIDS ™" and is a not for profit charity which helps disadvantaged school children in South Australia.

They provide breakfast and lunch programs, a mentoring program and Camp KickStart, a vacation care program. KickStart for Kids delivers food to over 300 south Australian schools and provides 50 000 breakfasts per week.

Different volunteering options are listed below.

BREAKFAST PROGRAM

Breakfast volunteers dedicate one hour per week to help run a before school breakfast program.

MENTORING PROGRAM

Mentor volunteers dedicate one hour per week to a school child who needs a positive support role in their lives.

READING MENTOR PROGRAM

Reading mentors spend one hour per week helping children with their reading.

DELIVERY DRIVING

Delivery driver volunteers dedicate 4=5 hours a morning to deliver food to the school breakfast programs.
