Future Meetings (Cont'd)

On **Tuesday 20 August**, we will have as guest speaker, **Dariusz Fanok**, Program Lead of the Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure (DPTI) **South Road Darlington Upgrade Project** and the associated **Flinders Link Project**.

This project is part of the Metropolitan Adelaide North-South Road System and this particular component covers a length of 3.3 km and is due for completion before the end of this year.

Sections of the new road system have been opened to traffic in recent weeks and other sections will be available for use progressively.

Dariusz received his Bachelor Degree with Honours in Civil Engineering from the University of Adelaide in 1998.

Some of the projects he has worked on include the Goodwood Junction Rail Grade Separation, recognised by winning numerous awards, the Marino Rocks Greenways shared path, Anzac Highway Underpass, O'Sullivan's Beach Rail Cutting Stabilisation and the \$100 million Adelaide to Melbourne corridor safety upgrade program.

More recently, Dariusz was involved with the \$160 million O-Bahn City Access Project.

We obtained a **Rotary Foundation Grant** to help fund this but the proposed sign proved far too expensive and the time limit on the grant was exceeded.

The Glenelg SLSC has now indicated that they would like to have an "all terrain vehicle", ATV or beach buggy, available to enable them to patrol a longer section of beach and to enable a more rapid response to be made during emergencies.

The make, model and price of such a vehicle is yet to be determined, but the SLSC have some funds set aside and we again hope to obtain a Rotary Foundation Grant to turn this proposal into reality.
