The first video conference meeting of the club was held on Tuesday 14 April using "Zoom" as the connection medium.

District 9520 has a Zoom licence and all clubs are able to use that licence for meeting purposes. Club secretary Peter Hammond has made the arrangements for us to be a registered user and advises us of the meeting ID and Password prior to each meeting.

On 14 April we achieved 21 connections with 23 members able to see and speak to each other. There were a few relatively minor problems during the hour long session but all members connected were able to participate. I think that it can be recorded as an "official" meeting of the club, number 1544.

A problem apparent was that as the number of connections increased, the sound quality decreased making understanding of the spoken word more difficult.

The following week, Tuesday 21 April, we had 20 members on 18 connections participate in that on line meeting number 1545.

As well as our club members, we had guest speaker **Damien Leach** on line to deliver a very informative talk on District Youth Programs.

Damien is a member of the Rotary Club of Campbelltown and Coordinator of District 9520 Youth Services. He will take on the much larger District 9510 Coordinator of Youth Services in 2020-2021.

The key to his address was that there will be no youth programs on offer during 2020 because of COVID-10 lockdowns and all preparatory work is going into making sure that we can achieve as much as possible during the 2021 calendar year.
