

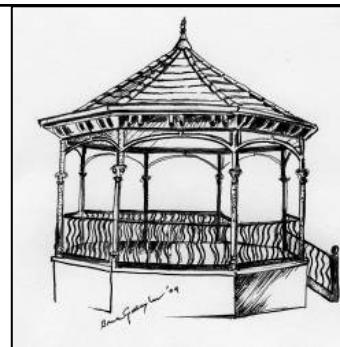

The Art of Press Photography



Bruce Postle

Last Monday Bruce Postle spoke of his career as a photojournalist. He was the son of a press photographer and at 16 landed a job with *Queensland Country Life*. He enjoyed the action of shooting photos for daily newspapers and the thrill of obtaining the best shot. He worked for *The Age* for nearly 40 years and became well known for getting the shot that no one else could. Sometimes through careful planning and sometimes through improvisation and sometimes with plain luck he would get the defining image.

A few years ago Bruce published a book of his images which completely sold out. He is now republishing those images along with further images in a 10-book series of *Iconic Images from 50 years of Australian Life* through Affirm Press. So far five books have been published with the [titles viewed on this link](#).

With the Melbourne Cup next week, Bruce particularly spoke about his book entitled *At the Track*. This book of 155 images showcases the colour and character of horseracing in Australia, from glory to disappointment, and tumbles to triumph, revealing the drama on and off the track. Bruce's skill is in capturing the unique bond between the horses and the people who work with them. One of Bruce's well known photos is of Tommy Woodcock and Reckless lying in the stall together on the day before the Melbourne Cup. Reckless won the Sydney, Adelaide and Brisbane Cups that year and ran second in the Melbourne Cup.
